Never allow a problem to be solved matter more than a person to be loved.



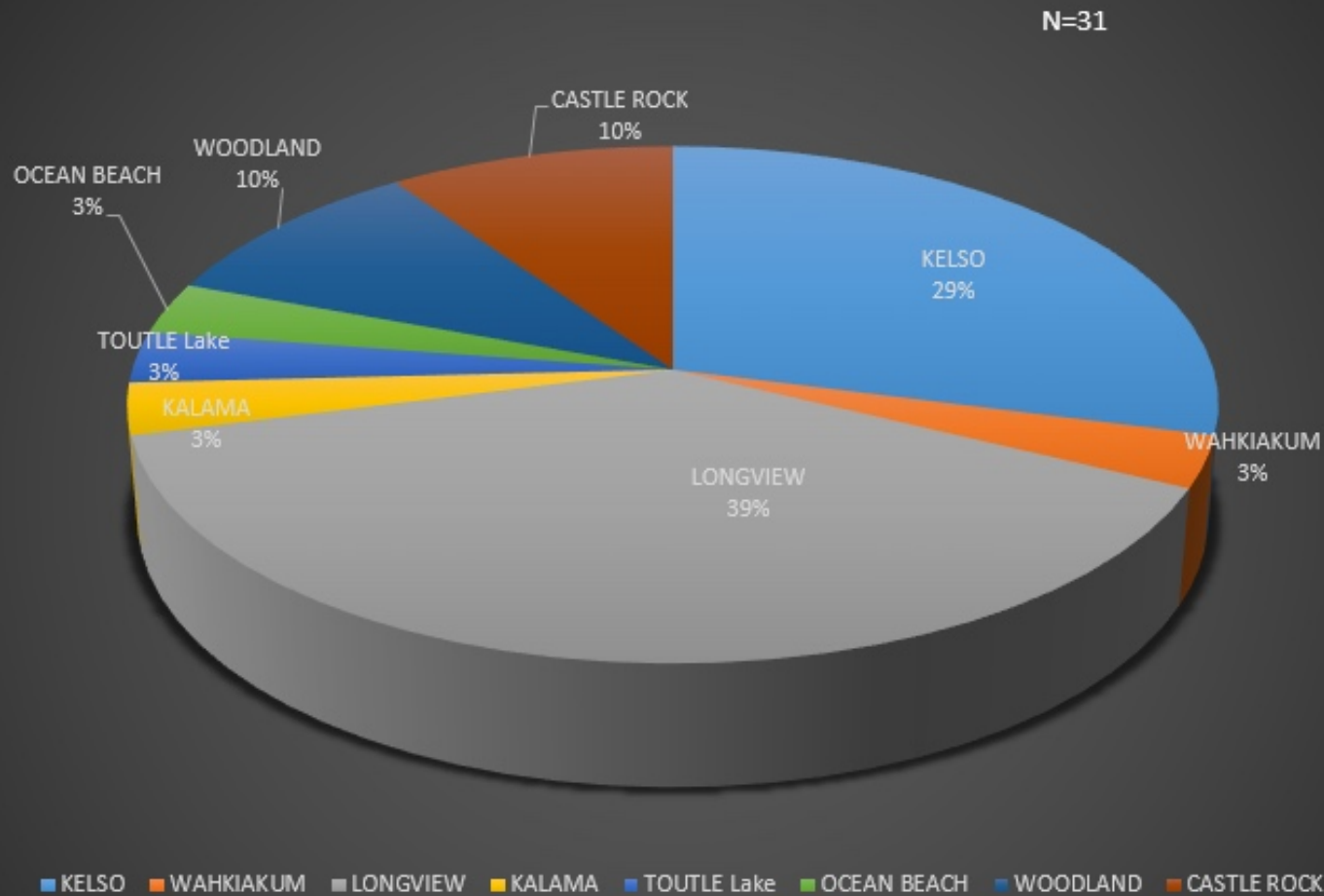

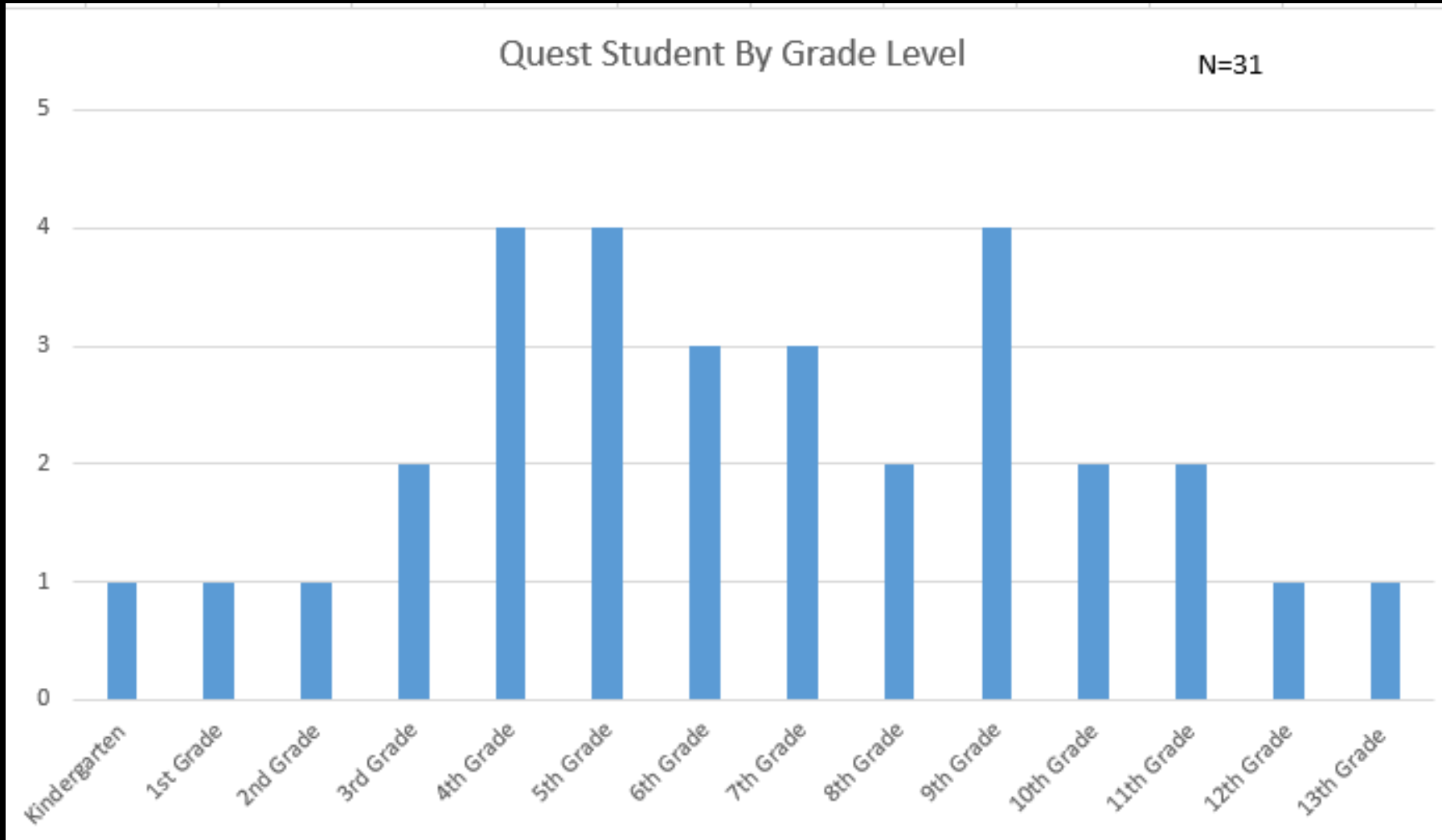
Number of Students from Each District

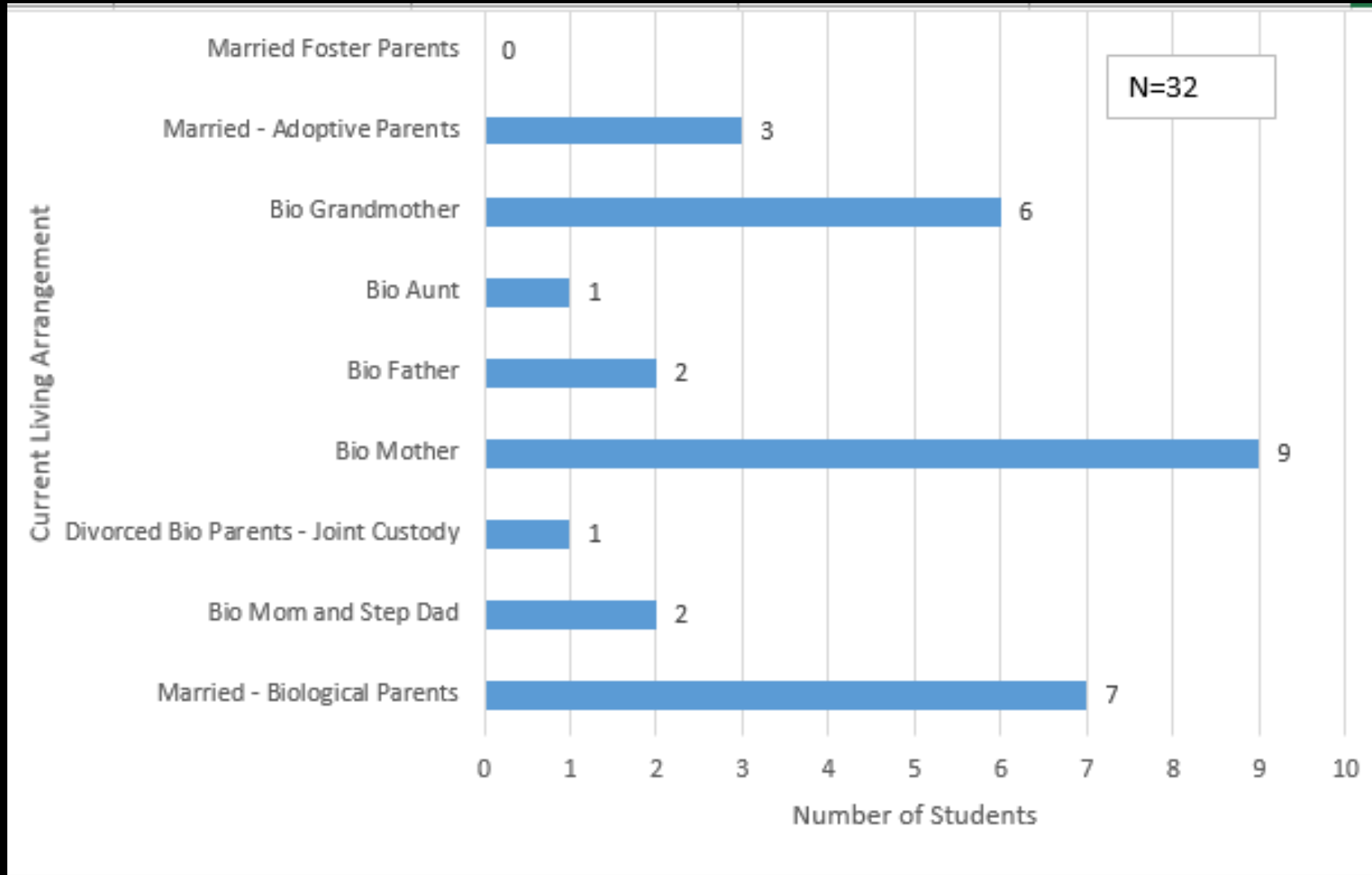
